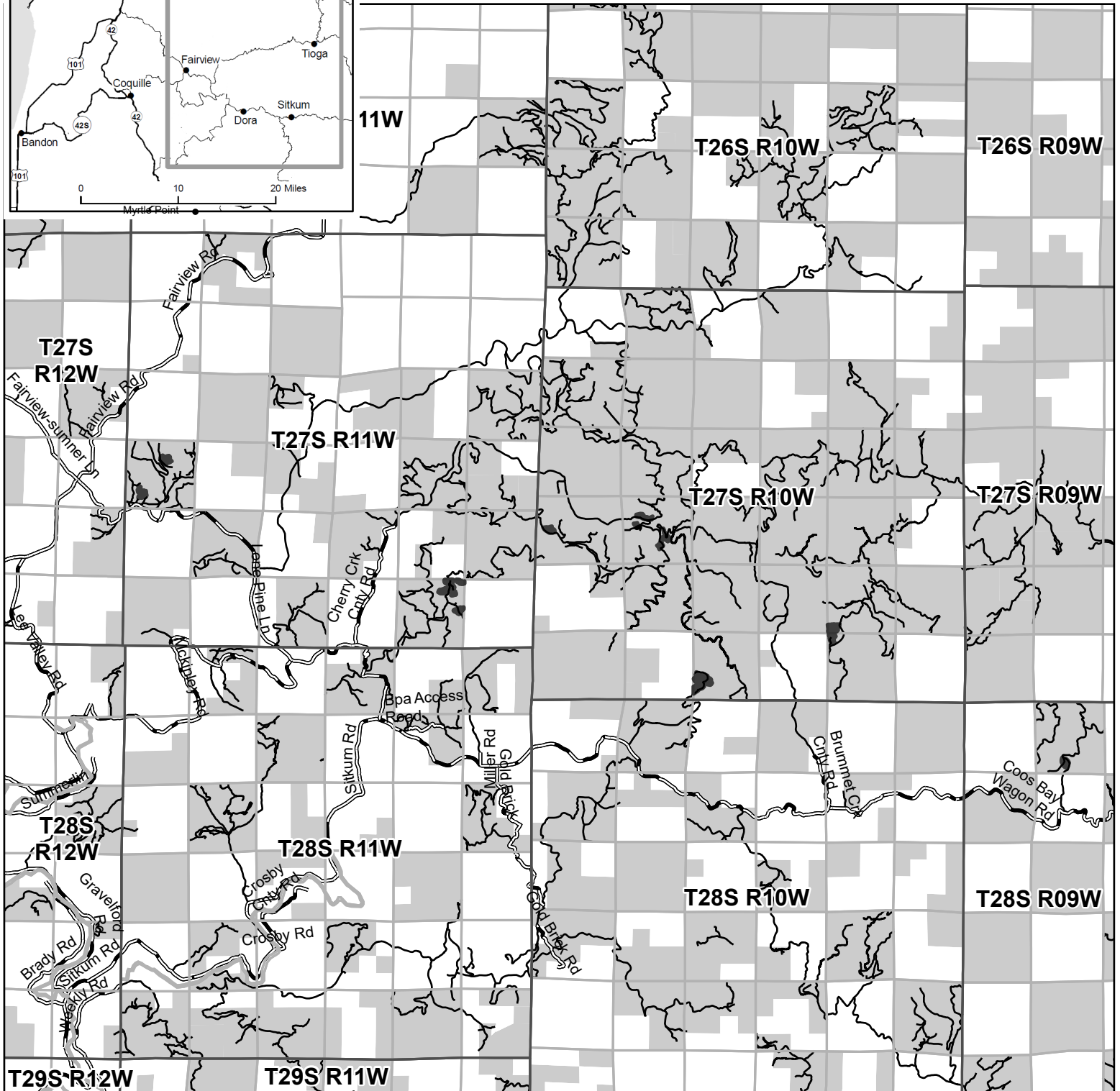
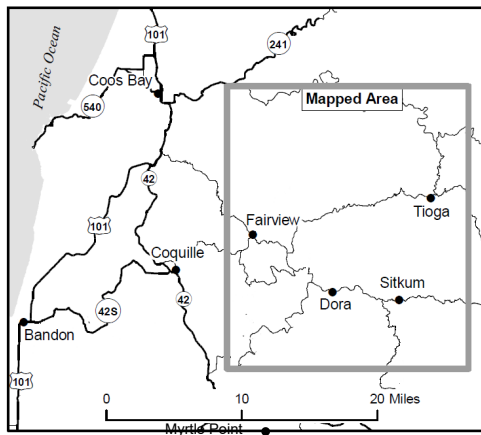


Coos Bay BLM Christmas Tree Cutting Map



NOTES:

- 1) The permit is only valid for BLM-administered land and Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest land.
- 2) BLM lands are shown in GRAY, young stands on BLM are BLACK. White is Private land.
- 3) Not all roads are shown on the map and some roads that are shown may not be driveable. Watch out for hazards such as downed trees, deep ruts, wash-outs, and oncoming traffic.
- 4) Choose and cut your tree early in the day and leave the forest before it gets dark – which can sneak up on you in the forest this time of year. Always remember most forest roads are not paved, so carrying a shovel and items in case you get stuck and something to tie down the tree on your way back. Dress warmly and take extra dry clothes. As always when venturing into the forest, carry plenty of extra food and water. Let someone know where you are going and approximately when you will return.

Most of all, have a great, safe, fun time while visiting Oregon's forests!
