## **BLM Moab, Utah**

# **STIPULATIONS FOR HARVEST OF CHRISTMAS TREES**

These special stipulations are part of your permit and must be in your possession when gathering and transporting Christmas trees on public lands.

1. Christmas Tree cutting is limited to Pinyon Pine only, 15 feet tall or less, and 8 inches DBH (diameter at base height) or less.
2. Permittee is limited to 2 tree permits per household.
3. All vehicles must stay on designated roads. During periods when the ground appears muddy and when deep ruts result from vehicle passage, all vehicles must stay on main roads.
4. All stumps must be cut as close to the ground as possible, and not exceed 6" in height.
5. Cutters will stay within the allowable wood harvesting boundaries of the permit. See attached map.
6. Cutting is not allowed within 100 ft. of any road. Cutting is allowed beyond 100 feet from the edge of any road in the permitted areas.
7. No Christmas Tree cutting is permitted in Wilderness Study Areas (WSAs). See attached map.
8. During periods when a fire closure is in effect, cutters will carry a shovel, for fire suppression, when a chainsaw is in use.
9. The permittee will ensure that no litter or trash is left in the area.
10. Harassment of wildlife or livestock is forbidden by state law. Leave gates as you find them.
11. Removal or disturbance of any artifact or cultural site is prohibited by state and federal law.
12. Permittee shall not cut, damage, or obliterate any bearing tree or survey marker.
13. Do not cut trees that have bird cavity holes or nests, or any trees located in areas designated on the map as excluding wood products removal.
14. Trees will be tagged before being transported.
15. It is your responsibility to ensure that the cutting area you plan to cut in is located on BLM administered public lands, and to have the permit with the special stipulations attachment sheet in your possession while cutting and transporting the forest products this permit authorizes.
